## WOW campaign

A reminder that we take part in the WOW (Walk Once a Week) campaign all year round. ## Parking

Park and Stride would certainly help with the parking around the school. We have received complaints from parents and from neighbours about unsociable or dangerous parking.

Please remember that:

1. Emergency vehicles should always be able to get through.
2. Neighbours need access in and out of their driveways at all times.
3. It compromises safety if you park near the corners of roads.
4. It compromises safety if you drive up Oakdene Close.

The school is aware that the very large majority of parents and carers are mindful of other people's safety and right of way at all times. We therefore appeal to the few to ensure they abide by this parking protocol. Can everyone ensure that anyone else who brings your child to school knows what to do.
