Parking

We have had a complaint from a neighbour about drivers parking across driveways in Oakdene Close. We have received another complaint about parked cars blocking Howard Road. We hope that this is not caused by parents and carers from Polesden Lacey Infant School.

We would like to politely remind everyone that we ask parents to park in Howard Road on the school side of the road, avoiding parking opposite any other vehicles and causing a blockage. **Emergency Vehicles must be able to pass at all times.**

We also ask parents to never drive up Oakdene Close at drop off and pick up times.

These measures are to ensure the safety of all of our families and also help us to maintain good relations with our neighbours.

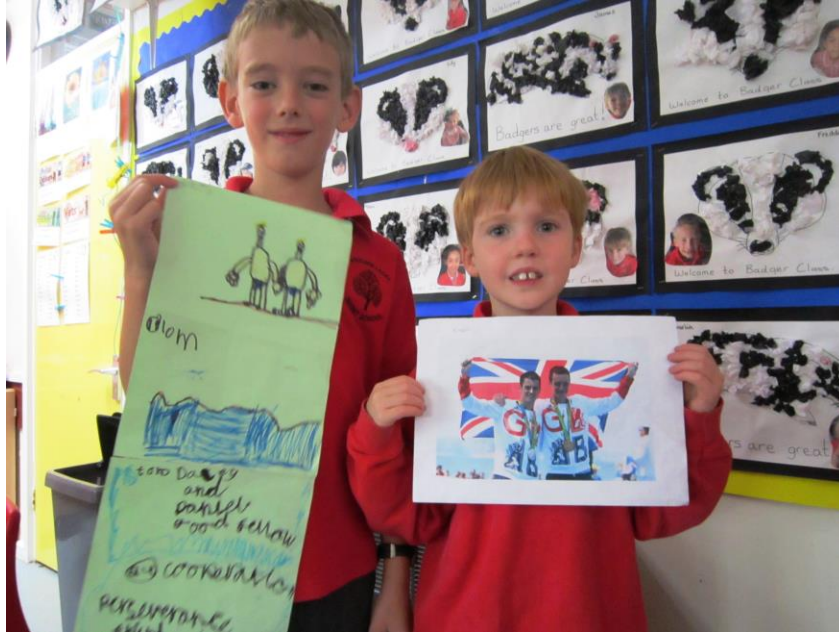
Park and Stride

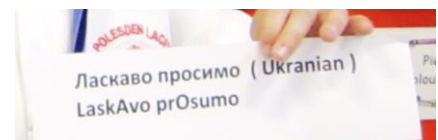
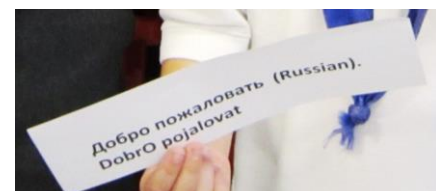
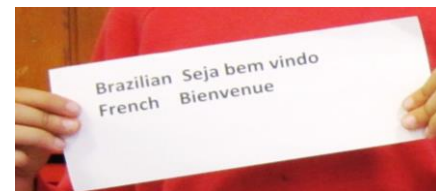
Thank you for your nominations sent in so far – we have shared these in assembly and will be starting a display soon.
