Waste Week from 19th - 23rd June

During Waste Week we will be finding out about the problems caused by rubbish and waste including every day household waste and dog poo.

We will also be looking for opportunities to be 'eco' warriors and make choices to look after our planet. With this in mind we hope you will help your child to take part in the activity outlined overleaf.

My Pledge to the Planet

We will be highlighting the problems caused by plastic waste.

We will be trying to work out whether it is possible to avoid making so much plastic waste. For example, we all know that we can take bags to the shops and not ask for carrier bags. Most people do this now. We want to pose the question "what else can we do?".

Ideas include:

- Using soap bar instead of hand wash in a plastic bottle or finding a plastic bottle that can be refilled
- Buying 'loose fruit and vegetables' even take your own reusable plastic bags to put them in
- Buy tin food in separate cans not ones joined together in extra packaging
