Physical Development

In PE we will be further developing our ball skills and think about how our bodies feel before, during and after exercise. Inside the classroom we will continue to fine tune our fine motor skills to improve our hand eye coordination and grip which will have a positive impact on our writing skills.

Communication and Language Development This half-term we will introduce the Rabbit Bag! Please keep an eye out for an email about this activity as it will involve your child bringing something in for show and tell when it is their turn! We will think carefully about asking and answering questions and thinking about our whole sentence before speaking. We will be encouraging the children to retell their own stories being influenced by class texts and using small world characters to support this.



Mathematics

We will begin to look at arrangments within and above 5, thinking about one more than a specific number. We will continue to verbally count to 20 and above and order numerals correctly. We will think about the fact that numbers above 5 can be split into 5 and a bit which will help us to make equal and unequal sets.

Literacy

This half term we will spend time looking at non-fiction texts to find out information. We will also learn and recite some simple poems linked to our focus of people who help us. We may have a visit from 'Evil Pea' which we will use as a writing stimulus. The children will apply their phonic knowledge to write words and short sentences.

Understanding the World

We will be thinking about people who help us and what we can do to look after other people too. Linked to this we will be exploring emergency vehicles and creating our own. We will investigate which objects roll and why, and use ramps to extend our predictions. We will also look carefully and excitedly for the first signs of Spring!

Expressive Arts & Design

The children will continue to have the opportunity to build their own models and use them in their play. We will also be planning and creating our own emergency vehicles that move, thinking about how to make the wheels work. This half term we will be experimenting with printing using wheels from different vehicles to create our own abstract art.
