Badger Class visit to British Wildlife Centre at Lingfield

Badger Class have planned to visit the British Wildlife Centre at Lingfield on **Monday 17th May**. We will travel by coach fitted with seat belts. Please note we will be back in school for pick up at the normal time of 3 pm.

Children should wear school uniform with trainers or school shoes but do not need to bring their book bags with them. Please bring a water bottle. If showers are forecast, please pack a light-weight waterproof jacket/mac. If warm weather is forecast please ensure your child brings a sun hat with them and that they, if necessary, are wearing 'all day' sun lotion. As the trip is on a Monday it is not possible for Jemma to prepare packed lunches in time for the children's departure, can we please therefore ask you to provide your child with a packed lunch from home on this occasion. If this is going to cause you a problem, please let me know as soon as possible. Can you please place your child's packed lunch, water bottle and light weight mac in a named rucksack. Please be assured that throughout this trip all necessary precautions will be taken to ensure that current Government Guidance is followed by us and the BWC in relation to Covid.

Our visit will link into our literacy and science Curriculum. Our focus for this visit will be to collect facts and information about nocturnal animals. Your child may be interested in researching this topic at home.
