Starting from 9th July until 17 September, Surrey Libraries are excited to launch the Summer of Reading. Organised by the Reading Agency, the theme this year is Gadgeteers, and has been developed in partnership with The Science Museum Group, whose leading exhibitions inspire over 5 million visitors each year. This year's Challenge will be a celebration of reading, science, and innovation. Gadgeteers will inspire children to discover the science in everyday things like music, fashion, sport, and cooking. Children can join the free Summer Reading Challenge at their local Surrey Library, help six fun characters and become a party-planning science visionary!

Designed for all reading abilities, children can choose whatever books, audiobooks, comics, ebooks or eAudiobooks they like to complete the Challenge. Every participant receives stickers and other incentives along the way – there is a reward for every book they read. Those children who read or listen to six books are presented with a personalised certificate and an amazing medal!
