Forest School and PE

Remember to ensure that everything is clearly named - it is easier for us to help reunite your child with their things if they are named rather than relying on the children to say, 'I know it is mine because it smells like mine!'

If you have to drive your child to school, please can you remember to park considerately. We work hard to maintain a positive relationship with our neighbours and it can be incredibly frustrating if cars are blocking drive ways or parked in a way that makes it difficult to maneuver up and down Howard Road. We did receive a complaint in the summer because a resident was unable to leave their drive way due to the way a car had been parked and due to concerns for the safety of the children and adults walking to and from school. The local community police officer does carry out adhoc patrols down Howard Road to monitor the parking, although as we say to the children we shouldn't behave in a certain way because we are worried about being caught but we should do what we know is the right thing.

Also remember that walking, buses, scooting and biking are great ways to get to and from school. Great for your health and better for the environment.
