Message from Ms. Mole

As we move into darker evenings, I thought I would take advantage of reminding you all of the importance of reading to your child. Not only is reading books and stories to your children one of the loveliest ways of passing time, it exposes the children to more sophisticated vocabulary, improves reading attainment, develops their cognitive skills, fosters a feeling of warmth and community when being read to, helps them make sense of the world, give them skills that they will use in school and later life as well as taking them on magical journeys. The list seems to be endless! Mrs. Bryan is doing some studying of her own through a course entitled 'Everybody Read—Leading Reading for Pleasure'. One of the startling facts that she has already learnt was regarding the drop in the number of children being read to regularly at home. In 2012 52% of 5 to 7 year olds were read to at least 4 times a week and in 2023 this number had dropped to 39%. Let's buck the trend at Polesden Lacey Infant School—snuggle down with your child and a wonderful book!

One of our Badger parents is currently studying and carrying our research into the impact of Forest School. Below, in the newsletter, there is a link to a survey she has put together. As a school we are very excited to be part of this project and I hope many of you will complete the survey. This will provide her with a wealth of information, adding to the success of the research.


Cards can be sent in any time from 1st December.


Christmas Performances


We are really looking forward to welcoming you to our Christmas performances.
