




### Newsletter - No. 12 29th November 2024

#### Message from Ms. Mole

In school we have been talking to the children about being a 'bucket filler'. This is based on a lovely book by Carol McCloud called 'Have you Filled a Bucket Today?' The concept behind this is that we all have an invisible bucket and every time that we do something nice or someone does something nice for us it fills our invisible bucket and a full bucket helps us to feel happy. The reverse of filling a bucket is to bucket dip. When we are unkind and dipping into someone else's bucket it makes them feel sad. The children seem to relate to this idea and can easily identify kind behaviours and when behaviours are unkind or hurtful.

This relates to learning that Year 2 did earlier this term about friendship and bullying. They thought about bullying, what it is and what to do if they believe that either they or someone else is being bullied. They learned that bullying is not ok and it must be stopped. Mrs Tredger helped the children to understand the difference between hurtful and unkind behaviour and bullying. (Bullying is intended to hurt, it happens more than once to the same person or people. Something that happens once may be mean and hurtful but it is not necessarily bullying.) This week the Governors reviewed our Anti-Bullying policy and I have attached the approved policy to the newsletter email. You can also access a copy of it on our website in the policies section.



In our circle time in two weeks the children will be discussing our 'Be a Bucket Filler code', which I will share with you when the children have worked their collective magic on it.


#### **Christmas Performances**

We are really looking forward to welcoming you to our Christmas performances.

This year there are three dates, one for Reception and two for KS1. We are aware that some parents will wish to attend more than one show as they have children in different classes, this is absolutely fine. NB. The show for KSI will be exactly the same on both dates but has been split to allow more room for parents at each show. We will not be issuing tickets this year but are restricting numbers to no more than 2 people per family per performance. We request that you do not bring siblings, unless they are one of your two tickets.

The Reception's Nativity will take place on Wednesday 11th December at 9.00 am to 9.30 am (approximately).

The Year 1 show (which includes the Year 2 children) will take place on Tuesday 17th December at 9.00am to 9.45am approximately.





If Year 1 & 2 parents are not able to attend on the date allocated for your child's class performance there is capacity for you to attend on the alternative date. All we ask is that you let the school office know so that we can put out the correct number of chairs. (The show for both dates is exactly the same)

Please keep an eye inside your child's book bag for letters providing costume details, song lists and words to learn. (Costumes for year 1 & 2 will simply consist of a specific coloured t.shirt along with PE tracksuit bottoms and plimsolls). These will be coming home over the course of the next couple of weeks.
