**NEWS** - The Surrey Environment Partnership has just launched <u>Surrey's zero waste map!</u> A tool created to give Surrey residents access to all the places they can reduce, reuse, repair, recycle or donate at the click of a button!



Glitter covered and non-paper gift wraps made from foil-based paper that spring back when scrunched cannot be recycled. Put these in your general rubbish bin.

#### Recycling collection

You can put this item in your green recycling bin for collection every fortnight. Any recycling that doesn't fit in your bin will be accepted if it is placed in a clear bag and left next to your bin on collection day.

#### **Dry Wood for Forest School Fires**
