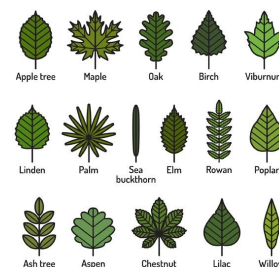
Values Leaves
