# **Diving Deeper**

This week we have introduced a new initiative to stretch and challenge our children in their maths learning, called 'Diving Deeper'. As part of our whole school mastery approach to maths we have a great focus on developing the children's reasoning and problem- solving skills. These skills are vitally important for ensuring that our children become confident and competent mathematicians who are able to think logically and apply their knowledge in various contexts. Our new initiative aims to encourage our children to extend their learning through a variety of activities (draw it, explain it, make a mistake, tell a maths story or prove it). The children in Squirrel and Badger class have really risen to the challenge and are having lots of fun with it!
