1. Last year our Upcycled Jubilee theme went down very well with the judges. Therefore we are again looking to create costumes and accessories for the children using as much upcycled material as possible. If you have any of the following we'd appreciate it if you could dig it out over the holidays and pop into the black plastic collection box at the front of school when we return:

- Surplus (but unused...) paper plates white would be great but we can use patterned or other colours too
- Brown, orange, yellow card
- Cardboard tubes such as toilet paper tubes, kitchen roll tubes or the tubes from wrapping paper
- String
- Black, brown, orange, yellow, grey fabric
- Any grey or brown fluffy fabric
- Large pieces of cardboard which could be from a flat packed large box or similar (think "placard" size
