# Friday 12<sup>th</sup> May 2023 at 9.15am

We are holding a coffee morning for Parents and Carers of children from St.Matthews Infant School, Eastwick Infant School and Polesden Lacey Infant School to attend a talk/coffee morning on the subject of dyslexia. The session will start with a presentation by Katrina Cochrane, founder of 'Positive Dyslexia', with a focus on infant age children. Katrina has spent nearly 25 years in education and is in her 20<sup>th</sup> year as a Dyslexia Specialist. She has held pivotal roles for both Dyslexia Action and The British Dyslexia Association. She has also co-written two books on dyslexia and is an inspiring leader in dyslexia training, supporting both children and adults impacted by dyslexia.
