Message from Mrs. Mole

At Polesden Lacey Infant School we have six values; Courage, Curiosity, Resilience, Respect and being Fair and Caring. In School we are passionate about making sure that these values are lived every day by both the children and the staff. These are simply leaf shaped pieces of paper that we write on saying how a child has shown one of our values. In your child's bag there is a blank leave for you to write on when you spot them showing one of our values at home. They can then bring the leaf back into school and give it to their class teacher. The leaves will then be read and given out during our celebration assembly on a Friday morning and finally they will be added to our Values tree. You can make your own leaves once you have used the one we have sent home, the children glow with pride when they share their values leaves with their peers and their teachers.
