Well done to all the winners this week.

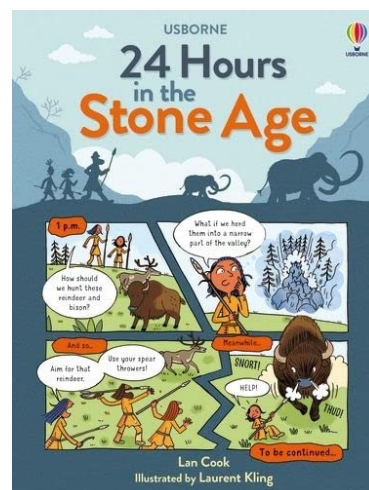


Book Recommendation of the week By James Year 1

We could also do with a few more bottles to make sure the bottle tombola doesn't sell out in 30 minutes! So if you weren't able to bring in your donation today it can be dropped off at pick up today, on Saturday between 3pm and 5pm or on Sunday between 9.30 and 12pm.

A few things to note:

We will be pre-selling games tokens and wristbands for inflatables at pick up today - this will enable you to jump the entrance queue on Sunday. Cash or cards welcome

Tokens and wristbands will also be available at the entrance on Sunday.

There are a couple of areas of the grounds which will be cordoned off due to weak tree branches. Please respect these barriers and ask your children to do so too - it's for everyone's safety.

All the games will be tokens rather than cash (tokens can be bought at the entrance on Sunday if you haven't pre-bought them), apart from the bottle tombola

Bar and BBQ will be cash or cards - if you can bring cash that helps at very busy times

There will be unlimited goes on the inflatables but after each "turn" the children will be asked to rejoin the queue for their next go - please buy a wristband for this at the entrance

If it's raining we will go ahead, with some alterations - so please still come and we'll do our best to make it work!

Parking is on Howard Rd, Dawnay Road and Crabtree Lane - please don't block any driveways and consider parking a bit further away if it's busy
